Refraction

(measurement taken to determine your eyeglass/contact lens prescription)

OptoMap

(allows physician to examine back part of eye without dilation)

Hearing Aids

Cosmetic Procedures

"Routine" Exams

(Vision and Hearing - No medical condition diagnosed)

Visual Fields required by Department of Motor Vehicles

The determination of non-coverage is not one that your provider makes but one that is determined by your insurance carrier.
